JANUARY TO MARCH 2025


DURING JANUARY TO MARCH 2025:

- **BUSIEST JANUARY – MARCH PERIOD EVER** – 6.43 million journeys were made over the Mersey Gateway and Silver Jubilee Bridges in January – March 2025, making it the busiest first quarter ever
- **SILVER JUBILEE BRIDGE BREAKS NEW QUARTERLY RECORD** – with over 1.03 million journeys made between January – March 2025
- **MORE CUSTOMERS CHOOSING TO REGISTER WITH MERSEYFLOW AND USE THE AUTO TOP-UP SYSTEM THAN EVER** – shown by almost 94% of customers using digital or automated payment methods
- **PCNs DECREASED SLIGHTLY AS A % OF OVERALL JOURNEYS** – over 97.8% of journeys were paid for on time

All revenue, either from tolls/charges or PCNs, contributes towards payment for the Mersey Gateway Bridge.


Year on year traffic increases

Total journeys and number of PCNs issued




PCNs continue to drop year on year

PCNs issued




Bridge usage from January – March 2025

Almost 94% of payments made via digital or automated channels




Total journeys and Penalty Charge Notices (PCNs)
