- A12.2.1 Of the following viewpoints those highlighted in bold have been identified to be illustrated by visualisations to demonstrate a representative overview of the range of visual effects.
- All photography was taken in February and March 2008 using a standard 50mm lens and an eye height of 1.7m AOD.
 - 1. South Liverpool / Speke Boulevard;
 - North of Golf Course;
 - 3. Spike Island;
 - 4. West Bank;
 - 5. Runcorn Promenade;
 - 6. Wigg Island entrance;
 - 7. Halton Castle;
 - 8. Wigg Island Nature Reserve;
 - 9. Trans-Pennine Trail at Cuerdley Marsh;
 - 10. M62 from footpath overbridge between junction 7 and 8;
 - 11. Moor Bridge Lapwing Lane;
 - 12. Pickering Pasture / Hale Point;
 - 13. Weston Link Junction;
 - 14. Footbridge (Central Expressway);
 - 15. Astmoor Road;
 - 16. Victoria Road.
- A12.2.3 The terrain and urban model used as a basis for the visualisations has an accuracy of +/- 20cm across 1km and when incorporated into the Terrain and Urban Model has a precise fit.
- A12.2.4 Since the final detailed design will be proposed in the future some interpretation of appearance and finished surfaces and colours has been necessary.
