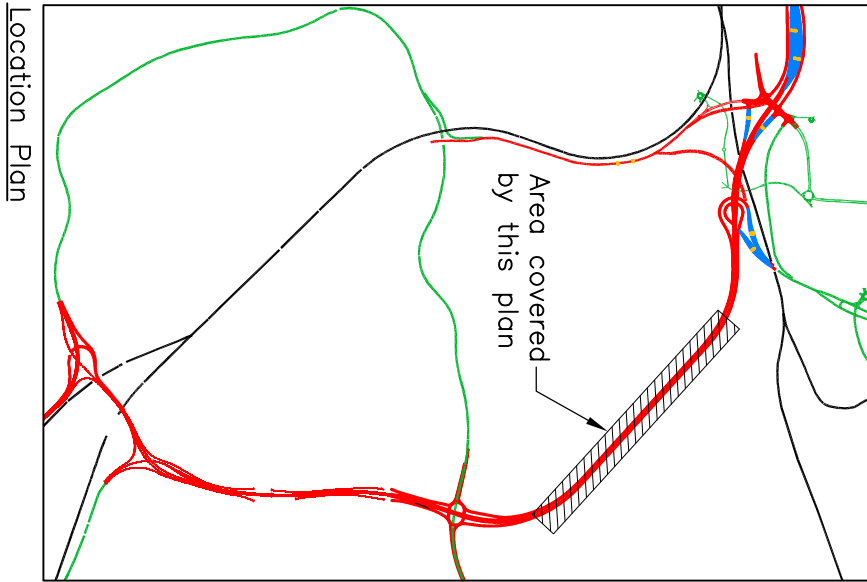

#### NOTES



- All dimensions shown are in millimetres unless noted otherwise.
- All levels are in metres above ordnance datum (m A.O.D.) unless noted otherwise.
- Structure consists of multispin approach viaducts and 1000m of cable stayed bridge consisting of 4 spans supported by 3 towers
- Piled foundations indicated as geotechnical information confirms that bedrock is at considerable depth.
- Geotechnical information taken from Form 1/C using latest B.R. information.
- Parapets to be normal containment (N2) vehicle parapets in accordance with 110/19.
- Bridge deck surface and subsurface water drainage to be combined kerb/drain system and through decks.
- Abutment back of wall drainage to consist of drainage layer and 150 diameter porous pipework connected into highway drainage via a rodable closed system.
- All exposed vertical concrete surfaces to receive a patterned profile finish with 50mm centres.
- Scheme lighting to be 15 metre high masts as indicated by Halton Borough Council design.
